

Grade 9 Social Studies | CBE Scope and Sequence September 2020 - June 2021

This scope and sequence has been created to ensure alignment between Hub Learning and in-class programming, and smooth transitions following potential staff/student absence. It is intended to support teachers and teams in engaging in collaborative planning for instruction.

Each reporting period has been divided into two segments, defining four quarters across the school year and each quarter lists the outcomes for concentrated teaching and learning in that approximate time period. Although there is a suggested order shown within each quarter, teachers will design teaching and learning according to their context.
